- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study eminent domain laws as 2 they relate to pipeline siting. 3 WHEREAS, pipelines may be built across multiple states, including this state, without a 4
- 5 WHEREAS, the eminent domain laws of this state may be used against property owners in 6 this state to locate a pipeline on their property without their consent; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the property taken by eminent domain may be taken without consideration for 8 the surrounding property and future uses of the property; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the burden is on the property owner to defend against eminent domain for 10 which the property owner incurs legal fees and costs;
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 12 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
 - That the Legislative Management study eminent domain laws as they relate to pipeline siting; and
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 17 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
