4	WHEREAS, the 2009 Legislative Assembly provided a total general fund appropriation for
5	the Department of Human Services of \$652.2 million, which is \$58.3 million, or 9.8 percent,
6	more than the legislative appropriation for the 2007-09 biennium; and
7	WHEREAS, the 2011-13 executive budget provides a total general fund appropriation for
8	the Department of Human Services of \$927.4 million, which is \$275.2 million, or 42.2 percent,
9	more than the legislative appropriation for the 2009-11 biennium; and
10	WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services is experiencing increases in caseloads and
11	program utilization, including an increase in the number of Medicaid eligibles from 53,644 in
12	December 2008 to 63,473 in November 2010; and
13	WHEREAS, the state of North Dakota is experiencing low unemployment, increases in
14	personal income, and a strong economy; and
15	WHEREAS, the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act will increase the future
16	expenditures of the Department of Human Services beyond the control of the state of North
17	Dakota;
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
19	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
20	That the Legislative Management study the causes of the increases in the Department of
