

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3044**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the election of at least  
2 one member of each legislative district to the Legislative Assembly each biennial election.

3 **WHEREAS**, under Section 3 of Article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota the Legislative  
4 Assembly shall establish a procedure whereby one-half of the members of the Senate and  
5 one-half of the members of the House of Representatives are elected biennially; and

6 **WHEREAS**, this has resulted in the members of each legislative district being elected every  
7 four years; and

8 **WHEREAS**, regular elections in each district every two years rather than only once every  
9 four years would provide for the will of the people to be expressed through its representatives in  
10 the Legislative Assembly in a more timely manner;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
12 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Management study the election of at least one member of each  
14 legislative district to the Legislative Assembly each biennial election; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management reports its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly.
