6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 15-20.4-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 created and enacted as follows:
- 9 Institutions whose only physical presence in this state consists of students enrolled in
 10 practicums, internships, clinicals, or student teaching in this state.
- 11 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 43-12.1-04 of the North Dakota
- 12 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. A student practicing nursing as a part of an in-state <u>board-approved</u> nursing education program.

15 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 12 of section 43-12.1-04 of the North Dakota

16 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

17 12. Upon written notification to the board by an out-of-state nursing program, a studentpracticing nursing as a part of a nursing education program preparing for initial oradvanced licensure as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse which isapproved by a board of nursing and is located in an institution of higher education that
offers transferable credit. A student practicing nursing as part of an out-of-state
board-recognized nursing education program, upon written notification to the board
and contingent upon clinical site availability.
