**SENATE BILL NO. 2102**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-12-14.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to extraordinary road use fees.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-12-14.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-12-14.1. Voluntary settlement of extraordinary road use fee charges.**

7 Before the complaint is issued pursuant to section 39-12-14, the owner, or the owner's  
8 driver or agent, may voluntarily pay the amount of the extraordinary road use fee, or may  
9 provide proof of surety coverage to ensure payment of the extraordinary road use fee, provided  
10 under section 39-12-17, plus any towing or storage costs. Any settlement, whether made by the  
11 owner, or the owner's driver or agent, must be presumed to be of a voluntary nature. A peace  
12 officer or a peace officer's designee is authorized to receive the settlement payment on behalf  
13 of the authority having jurisdiction of the road whereon the violation occurred. The extraordinary  
14 road use fees must be ~~remitted to~~deposited with the state treasurer to be credited to the  
15 highway fund.
