A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 and subdivision c to subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the process by which the noxious weed list is amended and the penalty for selling noxious weeds; to amend and reenact section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the control and sale of noxious weeds; to provide a penalty; and to allow the agriculture commissioner to use environment and rangeland protection funds for invasive species control.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4.1-47-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 10 4.1-47-02. Control of noxious weeds Responsibility.
- 11 <u>1.</u> Each person shall do all things necessary and proper to control the spread of noxious weeds.
- 13 2. No person may distribute, sell, or offer for sale within this state a noxious weed,
 14 noxious weed seed, or noxious weed propagating part.
- SECTION 2. Subsection 3 to section 4.1-47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 17 3. In adding or removing weeds from the noxious weed list the commissioner is not
 18 required to comply with rulemaking requirements in chapter 28-32.
- SECTION 3. Subdivision c to subsection 1 of section 4.1-47-31 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 21 c. A person who violates subsection 2 of section 4.1-47-02 is subject to a civil
 22 penalty not to exceed one hundred dollars for each violation.
- 23 SECTION 4. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND INVASIVE
 24 SPECIES CONTROL. The agriculture commissioner may use up to \$50,000 of the amount

- 1 available to the commissioner from legislative appropriation for the biennium beginning July 1,
- 2 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, from environment and rangeland protection funds for the
- 3 purpose of controlling invasive species as provided by section 4.1-47-33.
