- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
- 2 and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

26	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There are appropriated any funds received by the					
27	supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not					
28	otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the					
29	purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period					
30	beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.					

1	SECTION 3. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the			
2	state treasurer shall make such transfer of funds between line items of appropriation for the			
3	judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by th			
4	court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on			
5	properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.			
6	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 27-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
7	amended and reenacted as follows:			
8	27-02-02. Salaries of justices of supreme court.			
9	The annual salary of each justice of the supreme court is one hundred twenty-fourthirty-six			
10	thousand twenty-seven hundred thirty-nine dollars through June 30, 20102012, and one			
11	hundred thirtyforty-three thousand twofive hundred twenty-eightseventy-six dollars thereafter.			
12	The chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional three thousand fivenine			
13	hundred sixty-twotwenty-seven dollars per annum through June 30, 20102012, and threefour			
14	thousand sevenone hundred fortytwenty-three dollars per annum thereafter.			
15	SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
16	amended and reenacted as follows:			
17	27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges.			
18	The annual salary of each district judge is one hundred thirteentwenty-five thousand sixtwo			
19	hundred forty-eightninety-seven dollars through June 30, 20102012, and one hundred			
20	nineteenthirty-one thousand threefive hundred thirtysixty-two dollars thereafter. Each district			
21	judge is entitled to travel expenses, including mileage and subsistence while engaged in the			
22	discharge of official duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The			
23	salary and expenses are payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of			
24	judicial district is entitled to receive an additional three thousand twosix hundred			
25	eighty-twonineteen dollars per annum through June 30, 20102012, and three thousand			
26	foureight hundred forty-seven dollars thereafter.			
27	SECTION 6. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO			
28	SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding			
29	items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13			
30	one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:
