1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state water

2 commission; to provide exemptions; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state water commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

20 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
 items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13
 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

biennium. The state water commission shall report to the appropriations committees of the
sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

9 SECTION 3. SOVEREIGN LANDS ENFORCEMENT GRANT. The administrative and
10 support services line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$200,000 from the general fund that
11 the state water commission shall provide as a grant to the game and fish department for law
12 enforcement activities on sovereign lands in the state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,
13 and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amounts included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, any additional amounts in the resources trust fund and water development trust fund that become available are appropriated to the state water commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

19 SECTION 5. GRANTS - WATER-RELATED PROJECTS - CARRYOVER AUTHORITY.

Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to funding for grants or water-related projects included in the water and atmospheric resources line item in section 1 of this Act. However, this exclusion is only in effect for two years after June 30, 2013. Any unexpended funds appropriated from the resources trust fund after that period has expired must be transferred to the resources trust fund and any unexpended funds appropriated from the water development trust fund after that period has expired must be transferred to the water development trust fund.

SECTION 6. FARGO FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT FUNDING - EXEMPTION. Of the funds appropriated in the water and atmospheric resources line item in section 1 of this Act, \$30,000,000 is for Fargo flood control projects, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. Any funds not spent by June 30, 2013, are not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and must be continued into the next or subsequent bienniums and may be expended only for Fargo flood control projects. These funds may be used only for land Sixty-second Legislative Assembly

- 1 purchases and construction, and may not be used for administration, legal, planning, or other
- 2 similar purposes.
- 3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. The water and atmospheric resources line item in section 1 of
- 4 this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
