- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 transportation; to amend and reenact section 57-40.3-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the distribution of highway funds; to provide for transfers; to provide an effective date;
- 4 to provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the department of transportation for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department of transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

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1 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

- 2 SIXTY-THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
- 3 items approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly for the 2009-11 biennium and the 2011-13
- 4 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

- 13 The 2011-13 one-time funding amounts are not part of the entity's base budget for the 2013-15
- 14 biennium. The department of transportation shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 15 sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 16 July, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- 17 **SECTION 3. HIGHWAY FUND APPROPRIATION.** The sum of \$771,261,592 included in
- 18 the estimated income line in section 1 of this Act is from the highway fund and must be used by
- 19 the department of transportation for purposes authorized by the legislative assembly, for the
- biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. Any additional amount in the
- 21 highway fund that becomes available is appropriated to the department of transportation for the
- 22 purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and
- 23 ending June 30, 2013.
- **SECTION 4. LINE ITEM TRANSFERS.** The director of the department of transportation
- 25 may transfer between the operating, capital assets, and grants line items in section 1 of this Act
- 26 when it is cost-effective for construction and maintenance of highways. The department of
- 27 transportation shall notify the office of management and budget of any transfers made pursuant
- 28 to this section.
- 29 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 57-40.3-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 30 amended and reenacted as follows:

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1 57-40.3-10. (Effective through June 30, 20112013) Transfer of revenue.

- All moneys collected and received under this chapter after moneys are deposited in the state aid distribution fund under section 57-39.2-26.1 must be transmitted monthly by the director of the department of transportation to the state treasurer to be transferred and credited as follows:
 - 1. Twenty-five percent to the highway tax distribution fund.
 - 2. Seventy-five percent to the state general fund.

(Effective after June 30, 20112013) Transfer of revenue. All moneys collected and received under this chapter must be transmitted monthly by the director of the department of transportation to the state treasurer to be transferred and credited to the general fund.

SECTION 6. COUNTY AND TOWNSHIP ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM - CARRYOVER AUTHORITY.

- The sum of \$142,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the county and township road reconstruction program line item in section 1 of this Act, must be used to rehabilitate or reconstruct county and township paved and unpaved roads.
 - a. Funding allocations to counties are to be made by the department of transportation based on the needs assessment study conducted by the upper great plains transportation institute, titled "Additional Road Investments Needed to Support Oil and Gas Production and Distribution in North Dakota", dated December 9, 2010.
 - b. Counties identified in the study are eligible for this funding.
- Each county requesting funding under this section for county or township roads shall submit the request in accordance with criteria developed by the department of transportation.
 - a. The request shall include a proposed plan for funding projects that rehabilitate or reconstruct paved and unpaved roads within the county.
 - b. The plan shall be based on the upper great plains transportation institute study, actual road conditions, and integration with state highway and other county road projects.
 - c. Funds shall not be used for routine maintenance.

- The department of transportation, in consultation with the county, may approve the
 plan or approve the plan with amendments.
 - 4. The funding included in the county and township road reconstruction program line item in section 1 of this Act may be used for:
 - One-hundred percent of the cost of the approved paved roadway projects not to exceed the funding available for that county.
 - Twenty percent of the cost of the approved unpaved roadway projects not to exceed the funding available for that county.
 - c. Funding may be used for construction, engineering, and plan development costs.
 - 5. Upon approval of the plan, the department of transportation shall transfer to the county the approved funding for engineering and plan development costs.
 - Upon execution of a construction contract by the county, the department of transportation shall transfer to the county the approved funding to be distributed for county and township road rehabilitation and reconstruction projects.
 - 7. The recipient counties shall report to the department of transportation upon awarding of each contract and upon completion of each project in a manner prescribed by the department.
 - 8. Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to funding included in the county and township road reconstruction program line in section 1 of this Act. Any funds not spent by June 30, 2013, must be continued into the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, and may be expended only for county and township paved and unpaved road rehabilitation and reconstruction projects.

SECTION 7. EXTRAORDINARY STATE HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE - CARRYOVER AUTHORITY. Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to funding of \$228,600,000 in the capital assets line item relating to extraordinary state highway maintenance in section 1 of this Act. Any funds not spent by June 30, 2013, must be continued into the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, and may be expended only for extraordinary state highway

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY. Funding of \$228,600,000 in the capital assets line item relating to extraordinary state highway maintenance and \$142,000,000 in the county and township road reconstruction line item in section 1 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
