- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 28-01-16 and 28-01-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to statutes of limitations for civil actions.

# 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 28-01-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

### 6 **28-01-16.** Actions having six-year limitations.

7 The following actions must be commenced within six years after the claim for relief has8 accrued:

- 9 1. An action upon a contract, obligation, or liability, express or implied, subject to the
  provisions of sections 28-01-15 and 41-02-104.
- An action upon a liability created by statute, other than a penalty or forfeiture, whennot otherwise expressly provided.
- 13 3. An action for trespass upon real property.
- An action for taking, detaining, or injuring any goods or chattels, including actions for
   the specific recovery of personal property.
- An action for criminal conversation or for any other injury to the person or rights of
   another not arising upon contract, when not otherwise expressly provided.
- 18 6. An action for relief on the ground of fraud in all cases both at law and in equity, the
- 19 claim for relief in such case not to be deemed to have accrued until the discovery by20 the aggrieved party of the facts constituting the fraud.

### 21 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 28-01-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is

22 amended and reenacted as follows:

# 1 **28-01-17.** Actions having three-year limitations - Exceptions.

2 The following actions must be commenced within three years after the claim for relief has3 accrued:
