## ENGROSSED SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4015

1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress and the President to pursue peace through strength in 2 Irag and Afghanistan and disengage support American combat forces from on duty in these 3 countries and around the world. 4 WHEREAS, the goals of the United States in the foreign wars in Iraq and Afghanistan have 5 been to reduce prevent terrorist activity directed at the United Sates and States to create a 6 peaceful environment and to encourage a just rule of law for the citizens of those countries; and 7 WHEREAS, the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan are now the longest wars in the United States 8 history; and 9 **WHEREAS**, American forces on duty in Iraq and Afghanistan have served bravely in the 10 midst of the continued declining civil disorder in Iraq and the sectarian war in Afghanistan, and 11 merit the respect and support of all people; and 12 WHEREAS, now over 1 million American families have had a family member serve in these 13 overseas wars, and more than 4,000 Americans have died in these wars; and 14 WHEREAS, the continued cost of these wars in both the lives and health of American 15 forces and civilians and the cost to the United States government and our citizens of more than 16 \$10 billion per month cannot be sustained indefinitely; and 17 **WHEREAS**, it would be disruptive in the move toward democracy to abandon the cause to 18 which our brave patriots have sacrificed so much while we enjoy our safety and security here at 19 home; and 20 WHEREAS, the efforts of nongovernmental organizations to end violence against women in 21 Iraq and Afghanistan, bring community-based health, education, and economic development to 22 Afghanistan and Iraq and Afghanistan, and promote peace and freedom should be supported; 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 24 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

2	peace, freedom, and democratic rule of law in Iraq and a just rule of law in Afghanistan
3	withthrough the combined efforts of nongovernmental organizations and theinternational and
4	United States military forces, as they disengage from conflict and assist these countries in the
5	transition to peaceful and stable governments while continuing to disengage and safely
6	withdrawsupport and honor American forces from those countries at the appropriate timewho
7	have dedicated themselves to protecting the United States of America and helped to bring an
8	end to violence against women and all citizens and have promoted the just cause of freedom
9	around the world, and to support, through reasonable expenditures of funds, peaceful methods-
10	for decreasing appropriate means, our brave military personnel and their families, and to support
11	effective and secure governments in Iraq and Afghanistan which will decrease the global risk of
12	terrorist activities; and
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution
14	to the President of the United States and to each member of the North Dakota Congressional
