4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-05-20.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-05-20.3. Grounds for refusing certificate of title.**

7 The department shall<u>may</u> not issue a certificate of title or transfer a certificate of title upon-

8 any of the following groundsif:

- 9 1. When the <u>The</u> application contains any false or fraudulent statements or when, the
- applicant has failed to furnish required information or reasonable additional information
 requested by the department, or when the applicant is not entitled to the issuance of a
- 12 certificate of title under this chapter.
- When the <u>The</u> vehicle is mechanically unfit or unsafe to be operated or moved upon
 the highways. A vehicle is unfit and unsafe, if the vehicle has an out-of-state marked
- 15 title that includes a certificate for destruction or a notation on the title that the vehicle is
- <u>title that includes a certificate for destruction or a notation on the title that the vehicle is</u>
 scrap, parts-only, junk, unrepairable, nonrebuildable, a dismantler, or any other similar
- scrap, parts-only, junk, unrepairable, nonrebuildable, a dismantler, or any other similar
 notation.
- When the <u>The</u> department has reason to believe the vehicle is a stolen or embezzled
 vehicle or the granting of title would constitute a fraud against the rightful owner or
 other person having valid lien upon the vehicle.
- When the <u>The</u> certificate of title is suspended or revoked for any reason as provided in
 the motor vehicle laws of this state.
- 23 5. When the <u>The</u> required fee has not been paid.
- 6. When any<u>Any</u> sales tax or motor vehicle excise tax, properly due, has not been paid.

- 1 7. For<u>There is</u> failure to provide security for payment of basic no-fault benefits and the
- 2 liabilities covered under motor vehicle liability insurance on a motor vehicle as required
- 3 by chapter 26.1-41.
