AMENDMENT.** Section 5 of article X of the Constitution of North Dakota is 16 amended and reenacted as follows: 17 Section 5. Taxes shallmust be uniform upon the same class of property, including 18 franchises within the territorial limits of the authority levying the tax. The legislative assembly 19 may exempt by law exempt any or all classes of personal property from taxation and within the 20 meaning of this section, fixtures, buildings, and improvements of every character, whatsoever, 21 upon land shall beis deemed personal property. - 5 not exempt from taxation unless an exemption is provided by the legislative assembly. Except
- 6 as restricted by this article, the legislative assembly may provide for raising revenue and fixing
- 7 the situs of all property for the purpose of taxation. Provided that all taxes and exemptions in
- 8 force when this amendment is adopted shall remain in force until otherwise provided by statute.
- 9 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the electors, this measure is effective for city and county budget years beginning after December 31, 2013.
