## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1146**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 61-33-05 and 61-33-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to duties of the state engineer and the board of university and school
- 3 lands concerning sovereign lands.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 61-33-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 61-33-05. Duties and powers of the state engineer.
- The state engineer shall manage, operate, and supervise all properties transferred to it by
- 9 this chapter; may enter into any agreements regarding such property; may enforce all rights of
- 10 the owner in its own name; may issue and enforce administrative orders and recover the cost of
- 11 the enforcement from the party against which enforcement is sought; and may make and
- 12 execute all instruments of release or conveyance as may be required pursuant to agreements
- 13 made with respect to such assets, whether such agreements were made heretofore, or are
- 14 made hereafter. The state engineer may enter agreements with the game and fish department
- 15 or other law enforcement entities to enforce this chapter and rules adopted under this chapter.
- 16 The state engineer shall delineate and describe the boundary between sovereign lands under
- 17 management by the state engineer and nonsovereign lands. This boundary becomes the
- 18 permanent, nonambulatory boundary between sovereign lands and nonsovereign lands on the
- 19 effective date of this Act.
- 20 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 61-33-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 21 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 22 61-33-06. Duties and powers of the board of university and school lands.
- The board of university and school lands shall manage, operate, and supervise all properties transferred to it by this chapter; may enter into any agreements regarding such

- 1 property; may enforce all subsurface rights of the owner in its own name; and may make and
- 2 execute all instruments of release or conveyance as may be required pursuant to agreements
- 3 made with respect to such assets, whether such agreements were made heretofore, or are
- 4 made hereafter. The board of university and school lands shall delineate and describe the
- 5 boundary between sovereign lands under management by the board of university and school
- 6 lands and nonsovereign lands. This boundary becomes the permanent, nonambulatory
- 7 boundary between sovereign lands and nonsovereign lands on the effective date of this Act.
