## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2132**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-62 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to designation of a portion of the oil and gas impact grant fund for grants
- 3 to cities of fewer than seven thousand five hundred population or counties of fewer than ten
- 4 thousand population.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-62 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 <u>Impact grants for smaller cities or counties.</u>
- 9 <u>During each biennium, eight million dollars of the amount deposited in the oil and gas</u>
- 10 impact grant fund must be set aside for grants to cities of fewer than seven thousand five
- 11 <u>hundred population and counties of fewer than ten thousand population. Grants under this</u>
- 12 <u>section are limited to not more than five hundred thousand dollars for any city or county during</u>
- 13 each biennium to fund one or more projects in that city or county. A city or county must provide
- 14 equal matching funds for any grant awarded under this section. A city or county seeking grant
- 15 funding under this section must provide a project proposal that includes information on how
- ongoing expenses for maintenance, utilities, and other continuing costs will be funded from city
- 17 or county sources. Cities or counties eligible for grant funds under this section remain eligible
- 18 for grant funds as otherwise provided by law.
