- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to individual accident and health insurance coverage.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Health insurance coverage not required.

- 1. Regardless of whether a resident of this state has or is eligible for health insurance coverage under a health insurance policy, health service contract, or evidence of coverage by or through an employer or under a plan sponsored by the state or federal government, the resident is not required to obtain or maintain a policy of individual health coverage except as may be required by a court or by the department of human services through a court or administrative proceeding.
- 2. This section does not render a resident of this state liable for any penalty, assessment, fee, or fine as a result of the resident's failure to procure or obtain health insurance coverage.
- 3. This section does not apply to an individual who voluntarily applies for coverage under a state-administered program pursuant to the medical assistance program under title.

  XIX of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.] or the state's children's health insurance program under title XXI of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1397aa et seq.]. This section does not apply to a student who is required by an institution of higher education to obtain and maintain health insurance as a condition of enrollment. This section does not impair the rights of an individual to contract privately for health insurance coverage for family members or former family members.
- 3. This section does not apply to:
