- 2 Code, relating to registered agritourism activity liability.for an Act to create and enact a new

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. A new chapter to title 53 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
 7 enacted as follows:

9	<u>In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:</u>			
10	<u>1. "Agritourism activity" means any rural activity, including farming and ranching</u>			
11	activities, or any historic, cultural, or natural attraction, that is viewed or enjoyed by			
12	members of the general public, for educational, recreational, or entertainment			
13	purposes, regardless of whether the member of the general public pays to participate			
14	in the rural activity or to view or enjoy the attraction; provided, however, that			
15	agritourism does not include any rural activity in which an individual is paid to			
16	participate.			
17	<u>— 2. "Inherent risk" means:</u>			
18	a. Any condition or danger that is an integral part of agritourism, including:			
19	(1) Surface and subsurface conditions of the land;			
20	(2) Surface and subsurface conditions of the water;			
21	(3) Natural conditions of land, vegetation, and water;			
22	(4) The behavior of wild or domestic animals; and			
23	<u>(5)</u> Structures and equipment ordinarily used in farming or ranching; and			

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1	<u>b.</u> <u>The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner, including failing to</u>		
2	follow instructions or failing to exercise reasonable caution while engaging in an		
3	agritourism activity.		
4	<u>3. "Participant" means a member of the general public who engages in a registered</u>		
5	agritourism activity.		
6	<u>4. "Registered agritourism activity" means an agritourism activity that is registered with</u>		
7	the agriculture commissioner.		
8	<u>5. "Registered agritourism location" means a legally described parcel of real property that</u>		
9	is registered with the agriculture commissioner and on which a registered agritourism		
10	activity occurs.		
11	6. <u>"Registered agritourism operator" means a person that is registered with the</u>		
12	agriculture commissioner and that is engaged in the provision of a registered		
13	agritourism activity.		
14	<u> Registration - Requirements. </u>		
15	<u><u><u>1.</u> A person may become a registered agritourism operator by registering with the</u></u>		
16	agriculture commissioner.		
17	<u>2. The registration must include a description of the agritourism activity that the person</u>		
18	provides or intends to provide and a legal description of the real property on which the		
19	agritourism activity occurs or will occur.		
20	<u>3. The agriculture commissioner may not impose any fees or other charges to register</u>		
21	agritourism operators.		
22	<u>4. A registration under this section is effective for five years.</u>		
23	 <u>Registered agritourism operators - Maintenance of list.</u> 		
24	<u>The agriculture commissioner shall:</u>		
25	<u>1, Maintain a list of all registered agritourism operators;</u>		
26	<u>2. Maintain a legal description of all real property on which registered agritourism activity</u>		
27	occurs or will occur; and		
28	<u>3.</u> Maintain a list of all registered agritourism activities.		
29	<u>Liability of registered agritourism operator.</u>		
30	<u>This chapter does not prevent or limit the liability of a registered agritourism operator if the</u>

24	Part	icipant in agritourism activity - Assumption of risk.			
25	Exce	ept as otherwise provided, a participant assumes all inherent risks of agritourism. In any			
26	action fo	r damages arising from an individual's participation in agritourism, a registered			
27	<u>agritouri</u>	sm operator may plead assumption of risk by the participant as an affirmative defense.

12	Division of tourism - Copy of law - Provision to registered agritourism operator.
13	The division of tourism shall provide a copy of the applicable law to each person that
14	registers or reregisters as an agritourism operator.
