  BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
  SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-15-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 12.1-15-02. Interception of wire or oral communications Eavesdropping.
- 7 1. A person is guilty of a class C felony if hethat person:

amended and reenacted as follows:

- a. Intentionally intercepts any wire or oral communication by use of any electronic,
  mechanical, or other device; or
  - b. Intentionally discloses to any other person or intentionally uses the contents of any wire or oral communication, knowing that the information was obtained through the interception of a wire or oral communication.
  - A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if hethat person secretly loiters about any building with intent to overhear discourse or conversation therein the building and to repeat or publish the same with intent to vex, annoy, or injure others.
  - 3. It is a defense to a prosecution under subsection 1 that:
    - a. The actor was authorized by law to intercept, disclose, or use, as the case may be, the wire or oral communication.
      - b. The actor was (1) a person acting under color of law to intercept a wire or oral communication, and (2) hethe actor was a party to the communication or one of the parties to the communication had given prior consent to such before the interception.
      - c. (1)The actor was a party to the communication or one and all of the parties to the communication had given prior consent to such before the interception, and (2)
