- A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century

 Code, relating to using false identification to obtain alcoholic beverages.
 - BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Proof of age - Seizure of false identification.

- 1. A licensed retailer of alcoholic beverages or an employee of a licensed retailer may determine proof of age for purchasing or consuming an alcoholic beverage solely by inspection of one of the following:
 - a. A valid driver's license or identification card issued by this state, another state, or
 a province of Canada which includes the photograph and date of birth of the
 licensed individual:
 - b. A valid military identification card issued by the United States department of defense; or
 - c. A valid passport issued or recognized by the United States.
- A licensed retailer or an employee of a licensed retailer may seize a form of identification displayed as proof of age if the licensed retailer or an employee of a licensed retailer has a reasonable belief that the form of identification has been altered, falsified, or is being used to unlawfully obtain alcoholic beverages.
- 3. Within twenty-four hours of seizing a form of identification as allowed under this section, a licensed retailer or an employee of a licensed retailer must shall notify a law enforcement agency of the seizure and the law enforcement agency shall take possession of the identification within twenty-four hours after receipt of the notice.
