HOUSE BILL NO. 1062

Legislative Management

(Legislative Compensation Commission)

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 54-03-20 and section 54-35-10
2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to legislative compensation; to provide an effective
3 date; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as compensation for
8 services the sum of one hundred ~~forty-eight~~fifty-two dollars for each calendar day
9 during any organizational, special, or regular legislative session and for each day that
10 member attends a meeting of a legislative committee between the organizational
11 session and the regular session as authorized by legislative rule.

12 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota Century
13 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

14 1. Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as compensation for
15 services the sum of one hundred ~~fifty-two~~fifty-seven dollars for each calendar day
16 during any organizational, special, or regular legislative session and for each day that
17 member attends a meeting of a legislative committee between the organizational
18 session and the regular session as authorized by legislative rule.

19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
20 amended and reenacted as follows:

21 **54-35-10. Compensation of members and leadership.**

22 1. The members of the legislative management and the members of any committee of
23 the legislative management are entitled to be compensated for the time spent in
24 attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees at the rate

1 of one hundred ~~forty-eight~~fifty-two dollars per day and must also be paid for expenses
2 incurred in attending said meetings and in the performance of their official duties in the
3 amounts provided by law for other state officers.

- 4 2. In addition to the compensation provided in subsection 1, the chairman of the
5 legislative management is entitled to receive an additional five dollars for each day
6 spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees,
7 and the chairman of each of the legislative management's committees is entitled to
8 receive five dollars for each day spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative
9 management or of the committee which the person chairs.

10 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
11 amended and reenacted as follows:

12 **54-35-10. Compensation of members and leadership.**

- 13 1. The members of the legislative management and the members of any committee of
14 the legislative management are entitled to be compensated for the time spent in
15 attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees at the rate
16 of one hundred ~~fifty-two~~fifty-seven dollars per day and must also be paid for expenses
17 incurred in attending said meetings and in the performance of their official duties in the
18 amounts provided by law for other state officers.
- 19 2. In addition to the compensation provided in subsection 1, the chairman of the
20 legislative management is entitled to receive an additional five dollars for each day
21 spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees,
22 and the chairman of each of the legislative management's committees is entitled to
23 receive five dollars for each day spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative
24 management or of the committee which the person chairs.

25 **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Sections 1 and 3 of this Act become effective July 1, 2011,
26 and sections 2 and 4 become effective July 1, 2012.

27 **SECTION 6. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
