- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-39.6 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a <u>deduction from</u>reimbursement of alcoholic beverage gross receipts
- 3 taxes for operation of a smoke-free bar; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-39.6 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:

Deduction to reimburse Reimbursement to retailer for voluntarily maintaining a

8 smoke-free bar.

9 <u>A retailer who operates a smoke-free bar may deduct and retain revenue from</u>is entitled to

10 reimbursement of taxes paid equal to two and one-tenth percentage points of the taxes

11 imposed under section 57-39.6-02 upon sales of alcoholic beverages for consumption by

- 12 guests on the premises. The deduction under this section does not apply to retailers in whose
- 13 bar smoking is prohibited by law. To obtain reimbursement of the taxes paid, the retailer shall
- 14 certify to the tax commissioner that the retailer meets the requirements of this section and the
- 15 date the bar operated by the retailer became smoke-free. A retailer is entitled to reimbursement
- 16 of the taxes paid during the calendar year from the date the retailer became certified as
- 17 smoke-free and for each succeeding calendar year unless the retailer no longer maintains its
- 18 status as a smoke-free bar. On or before January 31, 2012, and each succeeding January
- 19 thirty-first, the tax commissioner shall issue a refund to the certified retailer of the allowed
- 20 reimbursement amount. For purposes of this section, "bar" has the meaning provided in section
- 21 <u>23-12-09.</u>

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable events occurring after June 30, 2011.
