- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 15 of section 57-02-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to determination of true and full value of property for property tax
- 3 assessment purposes; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 15 of section 57-02-01 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 15. "True and full value" means the value determined by considering the earning or productive capacity, if any, the market value, if any, and all other matters that affect the actual value of the property to be assessed. This shall include, for The relative age and location of residential property must be considered in determination of market value.

 For purposes of arriving at the true and full value of property used for agricultural purposes, factors to consider include the schedule of modifiers of the county, farm rentals, soil capability, soil productivity, and soils analysis. "True and full value" does not include any portion of the value or cost of improvements by special assessment unless the assessor has supporting evidence of an equivalent market value increase as shown by sales of property subject to those special assessments.
- SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2010.
