

HOUSE BILL NO. 1190

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-08 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to distracted driving; to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section
3 39-06.1-06 and section 39-06.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees for a
4 moving violation; and to provide a penalty.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except
9 for:

- 10 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, 39-10-42, 39-10-46, or
11 39-10-46.1, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 12 b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
13 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 14 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- 15 d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- 16 e. A violation of section 3 of this Act, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- 17 f. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one
18 hundred dollars.

19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
20 amended and reenacted as follows:

21 **39-06.1-09. Moving violation defined.**

22 For the purposes of sections 39-06.1-06 and 39-06.1-13, a "moving violation" means a
23 violation of section 39-04-22, subsection 1 of section 39-04-37, section 39-04-55, 39-06-01,
24 39-06-14, 39-06-16, section 3 of this Act, 39-09-04.1, 39-09-09, subsection 1 of section

39-12-02, sections 39-12-04, 39-12-05, 39-12-06, 39-12-09, 39-24-02, or 39-24-09, except subdivisions b and c of subsection 5, or equivalent ordinances; or a violation of the provisions of chapter 39-10, 39-10.2, or 39-21, or equivalent ordinances, except subsection 5 of section 39-10-26, sections 39-21-44 and 39-21-45.1, subsections 2 and 3 of section 39-21-46, and those sections within those chapters which are specifically listed in subsection 1 of section 39-06.1-08.

SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 39-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Distracted driving - Secondary enforcement.

1. The operator of a motor vehicle that is in motion or part of traffic may not engage in an activity that requires the use of the operator's sight unless that activity involves operating or using the whole motor vehicle or a built-in accessory. The operator may use an electronic device that transmits data automatically and does not require direct initiation by the operator, a voice-operated device, or a navigational system or may use an electronic device to obtain emergency assistance; report a crime; or report a traffic offense, hazard, or accident.
2. A law enforcement officer may not issue a citation for a violation of this section unless the officer lawfully stopped or detained the operator of the motor vehicle for another violation. Operators' license demerit points may not be assessed against any person for a violation of this section.
