1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-08 of the North Dakota

- 2 Century Code, relating to distracted driving; to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section-
- 3 39-06.1-06 and section 39-06.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees for a
- 4 moving violation; and to provide a penalty for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of
- 5 section 39-06.1-06 and section 39-09-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to care
- 6 required; and to provide a penalty.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota 9 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 2 For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except 11 for: 12 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26,2, 39-10-41, 39-10-42, 39-10-46, or 13 39-10-46.1, a fee of fifty dollars. 14 b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or 15 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars. 16 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars. 17 d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02, a fee of one hundred dollars. 18 A violation of section 3 of this Act, a fee of one hundred dollars. e. 19 f. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one-20 hundred dollars. 21 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is-22 amended and reenacted as follows:

11	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 39-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
12	and enacted as follows:
13	<u>Distracted driving - Secondary enforcement.</u>
14	<u>1. The operator of a motor vehicle that is in motion or part of traffic may not engage in an</u>
15	activity that requires the use of the operator's sight unless that activity involves
16	operating or using the whole motor vehicle or a built-in accessory. The operator may
17	use an electronic device that transmits data automatically and does not require direct
18	initiation by the operator, a voice-operated device, or a navigational system or may
19	use an electronic device to obtain emergency assistance; report a crime; or report a
20	traffic offense, hazard, or accident.
21	<u>2. A law enforcement officer may not issue a citation for a violation of this section unless</u>
22	the officer lawfully stopped or detained the operator of the motor vehicle for another
23	violation. Operators' license demerit points may not be assessed against any person
24	for a violation of this section.
25	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota
26	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
27	5. For a violation of section 39-09-01.1, or an ordinance defining care required in driving,
28	a fee of not less than tenthirty dollars nor more than thirty fifty dollars.
29	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-09-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
30	amended and reenacted as follows:

1	39-09-01.1. Care required in operating vehicle.
2	Any person driving a vehicle upon a highway shall drive the vehicle in a careful and prudent
3	manner, having due regard to the traffic, surface, and width of the highway and other conditions-
4	then existing, and shall give such warnings as are reasonably necessary for safe operation
5	under the circumstances. No person may drive any vehicle upon a highway in a manner to
6	endanger the life, limb, or property of any person. An individual may not operate a vehicle on a
7	highway:
8	1. In a careless manner;
9	2. In an imprudent manner;
10	3. In an inattentive manner;
11	4. In a manner that creates a hazard to the life, limb, or property of any person;
12	5. Without having due regard to the existing conditions, including the traffic, surface, and
13	width of the highway; or
14	6. Without giving warnings as are reasonably necessary for safe operation under the
15	circumstances.
