- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15-70-04 and 57-51.1-07.4 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to grants for nonbeneficiary students enrolled in tribally
- 3 controlled community colleges; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-70-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **15-70-04.** Submission of grant application Distribution of grants.

8 In order to qualify for a grant under this chapter, an institutiona tribally controlled community

9 <u>college</u> shall submit an application in the manner required by the state board of higher

10 education. The application must document the enrollment status of each student on whose-

11 accountwho qualifies for financial assistance under this chapter is sought. If an application is

12 approved, the board shall distribute to eachthe tribally controlled community college, during

13 each year of the biennium, fiveten thousand dollars for the first ten full-time equivalent

14 <u>nonbeneficiary students, and seven</u> thousand three<u>five</u> hundred four dollars perfor the next ten

15 full-time equivalent nonbeneficiary student. If the students. The remainder of any amount

- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 57-51.1-07.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

57-51.1-07.4. Separate allocation of state share of collections from reservation

3 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the permanent 4 oil tax trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,200,000, or so

5 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of

- 6 providing grant assistance to tribally controlled community colleges, for the biennium beginning
- 7 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. No more than fifty percent of the amount appropriated
- 8 under this section may be expended during each year of the biennium.
