- 2 Century Code, relating to documentation of variance reports for certain construction project
- 3 costs and progressprojects at institutions of higher education.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows: 7 Projects Construction projects at institutions of higher education - Cost and progress 8 documentation Variance reports. 9 Whenever any new construction, renovation, or repair, or other type of improvement 10 valued at more than enetwo hundred fifty thousand dollars is underway on the campus 11 of an institution of higher education under the control of the state board of higher 12 education, the board shall provide monthly project variance reports to the director of 13 the office of management and budget copies of all invoices and any other 14 documentation pertaining to the cost and progress of the activity. Each report must 15 include: 16 The name or a description of the project; a. 17 The expenditure authorized by the legislative assembly; b. 18 C. The amount of the original contract; 19 d. The amount of any change orders; 20 e. The amount of any potential or anticipated change orders: 21 f. The sum of subdivisions c through e and the amount by which that sum varies 22 from the expenditure authorized by the legislative assembly; 23 The total expended for the project to date; and 24 The schedule variance by number of days.

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1	2.	The	state board of higher education also shall provide to the director of the office of
2		mar	nagement and budget, at the same time as the project variance report required by
3	subsection 1:		
4		a.	A brief description of each change order included in subdivision d of
5			subsection 1; and
6		b.	A list of each public and nonpublic entity that has a contractually reflected
7			financial obligation with respect to the project.
