- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 2 to biodiesel plant production incentives; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as

5 follows:

6 <u>17-09-01. Biodiesel plant production incentives.</u>

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>A biodiesel plant that was not in operation in this state before July 1, 2011, and which</u>
- 8 has a production capacity of more than one million gallons [3785412 liters] may
- 9 receive up to one million five hundred thousand dollars in production incentives from
- 10 <u>the biodiesel production incentive fund for production in a fiscal year.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>The office of renewable energy and energy efficiency shall determine the amount of</u>
- 12 production incentives to which a plant is entitled under this section by multiplying the
- 13 <u>number of gallons of biodiesel produced by the plant and marketed to a distributor or</u>
- 14 wholesaler by five cents. The office shall forward the production incentives to the plant
- 15 upon receipt of an affidavit by the plant indicating that the biodiesel is to be sold. The
- affidavit must be accompanied by an affidavit from a wholesaler, retailer, or consumer
 affirming a sales transaction.

18 <u>17-09-02. Biodiesel production incentives - Payments for increased production.</u>

- 19 If a biodiesel plant that was in operation in this state before July 1, 2011, and which has a
- 20 production capacity of more than one million gallons [3785412 liters], increases its production
- 21 by the lesser of ten million gallons [37854118 liters] or fifty percent of its production capacity
- 22 during any twelve-month period beginning after July 31, 2011, that plant is eligible to receive
- 23 biodiesel production incentive payments under this chapter on its increased production.

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1 <u>17-09-03. Subsidy limitations.</u>

- 2 <u>The office of renewable energy and energy efficiency may not distribute more than one</u>
- 3 million five hundred thousand dollars per eligible facility annually in payments under this chapter
- 4 and may not distribute any payment that would create a negative biodiesel production incentive
- 5 <u>fund balance. If the incentive fund balance is insufficient to pay all valid incentive requests</u>
- 6 received in any quarter, the funds available must be paid out on a pro rata basis and obligations
- 7 <u>may not be carried forward. An eligible facility may not receive state payments that exceed a</u>
- 8 <u>cumulative total of seven million five hundred thousand dollars or for longer than five years.</u>
- 9 Change in ownership of an eligible facility does not affect the seven million five hundred
- 10 thousand dollar cumulative total allowed to be paid to that eligible facility under this section or
- 11 the five-year limitation contained in this section.
- 12 <u>17-09-04. Biodiesel production incentive fund Continuing appropriation.</u>
- 13 There is created in the state treasury a special fund known as the biodiesel production
- 14 incentive fund. All moneys in the fund are appropriated on a continuing basis to the office of
- 15 renewable energy and energy efficiency for use in paying biodiesel production incentives under
- 16 this chapter.
