- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 10 of section 57-02-27.2 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to extension of the deadline for counties to implement use of soil
- 3 survey data in agricultural property tax assessments; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 10 of section 57-02-27.2 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 10. For any county that has not fully implemented use of soil type and soil classification data from detailed or general soil surveys ferby February first of any taxable year after 2011, the tax commissioner shall direct the state treasurer to withhold five percent of that county's allocation each monthquarter from the state aid distribution fund under section 57-39.2-26.1 until that county has fully implemented use of soil type or soil classification data from detailed and general soil surveys. The amount withheld from the allocation must be withheld entirely from the portion of the allocation which may be retained by the county and may not reduce allocations to any political subdivisions within the county. The amount withheld from the allocation must be reallocated among counties through the state aid distribution fund, excluding any counties that have had amounts withheld from their allocations under this subsection.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2010.
