SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the
sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of making awards as
provided for under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending
