- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the cancellation of unexpended appropriations for the North Dakota university
- 3 system.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

54-44.1-11. (Effective through July 31, 20112013) Office of management and budget to
cancel unexpended appropriations - When they may continue.

9 Except as otherwise provided by law, the office of management and budget, thirty days after 10 the close of each biennial period, shall cancel all unexpended appropriations or balances of 11 appropriations after the expiration of the biennial period during which they became available 12 under the law. Unexpended appropriations for the state historical society are not subject to this 13 section and the state historical society shall report on the amounts and uses of funds carried 14 over from one biennium to the appropriations committees of the next subsequent legislative 15 assembly. Unexpended appropriations for the North Dakota university system are not subject to 16 this section and the North Dakota university system shall report on the amounts and uses of 17 funds carried over from one biennium to the next to subsequent appropriations committees of 18 the legislative assembly. The chairmen of the appropriations committees of the senate and 19 house of representatives of the legislative assembly with the office of the budget may continue 20 appropriations or balances in force for not more than two years after the expiration of the 21 biennial period during which they became available upon recommendation of the director of the 22 budget for:

- 23 1. New construction projects.
- 24 2. Major repair or improvement projects.

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- Purchases of new equipment costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if it was
 ordered during the first twelve months of the biennium in which the funds were
 appropriated.
- 4 4. The purchase of land by the state on a "contract for deed" purchase if the total
 5 purchase price is within the authorized appropriation.
- 6 5. Purchases by the department of transportation of roadway maintenance equipment
 7 costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if the equipment was ordered during
 8 the first twenty-one months of the biennium in which the funds were appropriated.
- 9 6. Authorized ongoing information technology projects.

10 (Effective after July 31, 20112013) Office of management and budget to cancel

11 unexpended appropriations - When they may continue. The office of management and 12 budget, thirty days after the close of each biennial period, shall cancel all unexpended 13 appropriations or balances of appropriations after the expiration of the biennial period during 14 which they became available under the law. Unexpended appropriations for the state historical 15 society are not subject to this section and the state historical society shall report on the amounts 16 and uses of funds carried over from one biennium to the appropriations committees of the next 17 subsequent legislative assembly. The chairmen of the appropriations committees of the senate 18 and house of representatives of the legislative assembly with the office of the budget may 19 continue appropriations or balances in force for not more than two years after the expiration of 20 the biennial period during which they became available upon recommendation of the director of 21 the budget for:

- 22 1. New construction projects.
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1 6. Authorized ongoing information technology projects.
