1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-10-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to ethanol dispensing unit labeling requirements.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 19-10-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **19-10-03.1. Retail sale of alcohol-blended gasoline - Label requirements.**

7 ~~No~~A dealer may not sell at retail alcohol-blended gasoline unless the dispensing unit and  
8 any price advertising bear the name of the alcohol blended with the gasoline if the  
9 alcohol-blended gasoline consists of one percent or more by volume of any alcohol ~~and the~~  
10 ~~dispensing unit bears the ethanol promotion and information council label or logo.~~ The  
11 disclosure must be in letters at least the same size as those used for the label of the basic  
12 grade of gasoline and must be next to the gasoline grade label. A producer of alcohol-blended  
13 gasoline may provide a retailer with a label promoting the benefits of alcohol-blended gasoline,  
14 if the label at least meets the requirements of this section.
