- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 40-63-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 <u>Century Code, relating to restrictions on renaissance fund organization investments in</u>
- 3 <u>enterprises owned by renaissance fund organization officers or employees;</u> to amend and
- 4 reenact subsections 2 and 5 of section 40-63-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 5 relating to renaissance fund organization income tax credits; and to provide an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

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SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 40-63-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

9 The purpose of a renaissance fund organization is solely to raise funds to be used to 2. 10 make investments infinance zone projects and to make investments other projects 11 located in designated renaissance zone citieszones. A renaissance fund organization 12 may provide financing to projects undertaken by individuals, partnerships, limited 13 partnerships, limited liability companies, trusts, corporations, nonprofit organizations, 14 and public entities. The financing may include any combination of equity investments, 15 loans, guarantees, and commitments for financing. The amount of financing is not 16 limited by this chapter.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 40-63-07 of the North Dakota Century
Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

5. The total amount of credits allowed under this section may not exceed, in the
aggregate, seveneight million five hundred thousand dollars for investments in
renaissance fund organizations. A renaissance fund organization that has received
investments that qualify for these additionalthe credits under this subsection may
notshall use more than fifty percent of suchthose investments for organizationinvestments outside ofto finance projects within a renaissance zone.

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1	SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 40-63-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
2	created and enacted as follows:
3	Renaissance fund organization officers and employees may be actively involved in the
4	enterprises in which the renaissance fund organization invests but the renaissance
5	fund organization may not invest in any enterprise if any one renaissance fund
6	organization officer or employee owns more than forty-nine percent of the ownership
7	interest in the enterprise. A renaissance fund organization may not invest in an
8	enterprise if renaissance fund organization officers and employees collectively own
9	more than forty-nine percent of the ownership interests, either through direct
10	ownership or through ownership of interest in a passthrough entity.
11	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This The changes in sections 1 and 2 of this Act is requiring
12	a renaissance fund organization to limit its financing to projects located in a renaissance zone
13	are effective for taxable years beginningnew financing initiated after December 31, 20102011.
14	Section 3 of this Act is effective for investments made in or by a renaissance fund organization
15	after December 31, 2011.
