

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with House Amendments
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2145**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 5-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to alcoholic beverage license exception for nonprofit organizations.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 5-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended
5 and reenacted as follows:

6 **5-02-01. State and local retail license required - Exception.**

- 7 1. Except as otherwise provided in section 5-02-01.1, any person engaging in the sale of
8 alcoholic beverages at retail without first securing an appropriate license from the
9 attorney general and a local license from the governing body of any city, or if ~~said~~the
10 business is located outside the corporate limits of a city, the board of county
11 commissioners or the governing body of an Indian tribe, as the location requires, is
12 guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 13 2. This section does not apply to public carriers engaged in interstate commerce.
- 14 3. This section does not apply to a nonprofit organization that sells an alcoholic beverage
15 as part of a fundraising activity. As used in this subsection, fundraising activity includes
16 an auction, raffle, or other prize contest for which consideration is given. If the
17 alcoholic beverage is sold as part of a fundraising event, the sale may not be for
18 consumption at that event.
