4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$640,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of awarding a healthy school program grant to the southeast education cooperative regional education association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. Under the direction provided by the staff of the heart disease and stroke prevention program, the grant recipient shall provide to its member school districts and coordinate with the seven other regional education associations in the state so those associations can provide to their memberdistricts the following: 1. Activities designed to improve the physical education curricula and the delivery of physical education at the elementary and high school levels; Hands on instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to students within the healthcurriculum: Assistance with automated external defibrillator maintenance and readiness monitoring; and Any other health-related programs identified by the regional education associationsand supported by the superintendent of public instruction through the North Dakotacoordinated school health program.

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$160,000, or so much of the
