## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1369**

A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-10-14.2 of the North Dakota Century Code,
relating to a performance and accountability report by the state board of higher education; and
to provide legislative intent.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-14.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- amended and reenacted as follows:
   15-10-14.2. Higher education system strategic plan Reports.
  - The state board of higher education shall adopt a strategic planning process and develop a strategic plan to define and prioritize university system goals and objectives.
     The board shall provide an annual performance and accountability report regarding performance and progress toward the goals outlined in the university system's strategic plan and accountability measures.
  - The report required by subsection 1 must include the following information for the past
    three bienniums for each institution, including separate information for the university of
    North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences, school of law, and aviation
    programs:
    - a. Include a detailed analysis of cost increases within the university system which are not directly related to classroom instruction;
    - b. Document and describe, for a period of four bienniums, all full time equivalent positions in the university system which are not classroom instructor positions;
    - c. Include information regarding the necessity for and salary history of all positions described in subdivision b which have an annual salary in excess of one hundred thousand dollars:
    - <u>Describe actions taken by the university system to reduce nonclassroom costs;</u>

31	reduced by at least the same percentage as tuition rates are increased at	each institution
