- 7 <u>1. Each school district shall develop a policy to prohibit the bullying of one student by</u>
 8 <u>another. The policy must include:</u>
 - a. The procedure to be followed by a student in reporting an alleged act of bullying to a designated employee at the student's school:
- 11 <u>b.</u> The procedure to be followed by school personnel in investigating a report of alleged bullying:
- 13 <u>c.</u> A procedure for notifying the parents of each student involved in an incident
 14 <u>determined by school personnel to constitute bullying; and</u>
 - d. <u>Disciplinary measures to be imposed by the student's school if a student is found to have engaged in bullying.</u>
- 17 2. For purposes of this section, "bullying" means any physical act, verbal utterance, or
 18 written or electronic communication that is directed toward a student and which:
 - <u>a.</u> Causes the student to fear harm to the student's person or property;
- b. Has a detrimental effect on the student's physical or mental health;
- 21 <u>c. Interferes substantially with the student's academic performance; or</u>
- d. Interferes substantially with the student's ability to participate in or benefit from
 services, activities, or privileges provided by a school district.

- 1 3. A policy developed under this section may not impede or preclude a student, the
- 2 <u>student's parents, or school officials from directly reporting to law enforcement officials</u>
- 3 any behavior that constitutes a violation of criminal law under title 12.1.
