- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to world history as a required high school course.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-21-02.1. High school graduation Diploma requirements.
- 7 Except as provided in section 15.1-21-02.3, before a school district, a nonpublic high
- 8 school, or the center for distance education issues a high school diploma to a student, the
- 9 student must have successfully completed the following twenty-two units of high school
- 10 coursework:
- Four units of English language arts from a sequence that includes literature,
  composition, and speech;
- 13 2. Three units of mathematics;
- 14 3. Three units of science, including:
- a. One unit of physical science;
- b. One unit of biology; and
- 17 c. (1) One unit of any other science; or
- 18 (2) Two one-half units of any other science;
- 19 4. Three Four units of social studies, including:
- a. One unit of United States history;
- b. One unit of world history;
- 22 <u>c.</u> (1) One-half unit of United States government and one-half unit of economics;
- 23 or
- 24 (2) One unit of problems of democracy; and

- One unit or two one-half units of any other social studies, which may include civics, civilization, geography and history, multicultural studies, North Dakota studies, psychology, <u>and</u> sociology<del>, and world history</del>;
- 4 5. a. One unit of physical education; or
- 5 b. One-half unit of physical education and one-half unit of health;
- 6 6. Three units of:
- 7 a. Foreign languages;
- 8 b. Native American languages;
- 9 c. Fine arts; or
- d. Career and technical education courses; and
- 7. Any five four additional units.
