- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide a definition of navigable waters for all state agencies and purposes.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **SECTION 1**.
- 4 Navigable waters Defined.
- 5 Navigable waters for all state agencies and purposes means any waters which were in fact
- 6 <u>navigable at time of statehood. Navigable at time of statehood means used or were susceptible</u>
- 7 of being used in their ordinary condition as highways for commerce over which trade and travel
- 8 were or may have been conducted in the customary modes of trade on water, including the
- 9 Missouri River, the Yellowstone River, the Red River of the North from Wahpeton to the
- 10 Canadian border, the Bois de Sioux River from Wahpeton to the South Dakota border, the
- 11 James River, the Upper Des Lacs Lake, Devils Lake, Painted Woods Lake, and Sweetwater
- 12 <u>Lake. With respect to navigable rivers, the term navigable waters includes waters up to the first</u>
- 13 crossing.
