- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-13-02, 15.1-13-04, 15.1-13-05, and
- 2 15.1-13-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the education standards and practices
- 3 board; to provide for a transition; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-13-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **15.1-13-02.** Education standards and practices board Membership.
- 8 1. The governor shall appoint to the education standards and practices board:
- 9 a. Four individuals who are public school classroom teachers;
- 10 b. One individual who is a nonpublic school classroom teacher;
- 11 c. Two individuals who are school board members;
- 12 d. Two individuals who are administrators; and
- 13 e. One dean of a college of education or chairman of a department of education.
- 14 The education standards and practices board consists of:
- 15 <u>1.</u> <u>The following gubernatorial appointed members:</u>
- 16 <u>a.</u> <u>One individual employed as an early childhood teacher;</u>
- 17 <u>b.</u> <u>One individual employed as an elementary teacher;</u>
- 18 <u>c.</u> <u>One individual employed as a middle school teacher;</u>
- 19 <u>d.</u> <u>One individual employed as a high school teacher;</u>
- 20 <u>e.</u> <u>One school board member;</u>
- 21 <u>f.</u> <u>One school administrator holding a doctoral degree;</u>
- 22 g. <u>The dean of a college of arts or the dean's designee;</u>
- 23 <u>h.</u> <u>The dean of a college of sciences or the dean's designee;</u>
- 24 <u>i.</u> <u>The dean of a college of education or the dean's designee;</u>

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1		<u>j.</u>	The president or chairman of a professional licensing board in this state;
2		<u>k.</u>	The parent of a student enrolled in an elementary or high school;
3		<u>l.</u>	Two members of the legislative assembly; and
4		<u>m.</u>	One resident of this state:
5	2.	<u>The</u>	e lieutenant governor, who shall serve as the chairman; and
6	<u>3.</u>	The	e superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's designee, who shall

8	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-13-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
9	amended and reenacted as follows:		
10	15.1-13-04. Term of office - Vacancy.		
11	The term of office for a member of the board is threetwo years, beginning on July first of the		
12	<del>year of appointment. No person may serve for<u>1, 2011. A member may not serve</u> more than</del>		
13	twothree consecutive terms. If a vacancy occurs, it must be filled for the duration of the		
14	unexpired term in the same manner as an original appointment.		
15	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-13-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
16	amended and reenacted as follows:		
17	15.1-13-05. Officers.		
18	The <del>board annually shall select a</del> chairman <del>and shall elect one member to serve as</del> a vice		
19	chairman. The executive director of the board or the executive director's designee shall serve		
20	as secretary.		
21	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-13-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
22	amended and reenacted as follows:		
23	15.1-13-08. Board duties.		
24	<u>1.</u>	The	e board shall:

Appoint an executive director to serve at its discretion .; and 7 <del>8.</del> Authorize the executive director to employ personnel, subject to approval by the h. 8 board. 9 In addition to any other duties set forth in this section, during the 2011-13 biennium, <u>2.</u> 10 the board shall: 11 Review the criteria for and manner in which teacher licensure is undertaken. <u>a.</u> 12 including provisional licensure, reciprocal licensure, and reentry licensure; 13 Review the criteria for and manner in which disciplinary action is taken against an b. 14 individual who fails to abide by the tenets of the teaching profession; 15 Evaluate the established standards for teacher preparation programs, including <u>C.</u> 16 the sufficiency of academic and pedagogical requirements, and compare the 17 curricular requirements for majors within the colleges of education to those of 18 other colleges; 19 Review the manner in which other professional licensing boards provide for all <u>d.</u> 20 forms of licensure, determine professional development requirements, and 21 provide for reporting of professional development activities as a condition of 22 continued licensure; 23 Review the supporting organization to ensure that its overall structure, <u>e.</u> 24 functionality, and leadership allow it to fully and capably meet all current and 25 prospective duties; and 26 Recommend any statutory changes deemed necessary to the sixty-third <u>f.</u> 27 legislative assembly. 28 SECTION 5. TRANSITION. The term of any individual appointed to the education 29 standards and practices board before July 1, 2011, expires on June 30, 2011. In accordance 30 with section 15.1-13-02, the governor may appoint any qualified individual who served on the

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- 1 education standards and practices board before July 1, 2011, and shall consider the
- 2 appointment to be an initial appointment for the purpose of determining term limitations.
- 3 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on June 30, 2011.
- 4 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
