1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-01-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to publication of park district board proceedings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 40-01-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

40-01-09.1. Publication of city government <u>and park district</u> proceedings - Electorate
to decide.

8 Beginning with the 19962012 biennial municipal elections, and every four years thereafter, 9 all cities in North Dakota, regardless of their form of government, must shall put on the ballot the 10 guestion of whether the minutes of its governing body shalland its park district board of park 11 commissioners must be published in its official newspaper. If voters approve publication, the 12 governing body and board of park commissioners shall, within seven days after each of its-13 meetingsmeeting, give itsthe official newspaper, for publication, the complete minutes, or a 14 complete summary showing the substantive actions taken at the meeting. 15 Roll call votes must be published, but may be indicated as "unanimous" when appropriate. 16 A list of the individual checks written by the city or park district and approved by the governing 17 body of the city or board of park commissioners, showing the payee and the amount of each 18 check, must be published. However, employee salary checks need not be published if the 19 governing body or board of park commissioners elects to publish an annual salary schedule for 20 each employee. When applicable, thesethe minutes may be labeled as being published subject

21 to the governing body's review and revision. The minutes shallmust continue to be published

22 until disapproved at a succeeding quadrennial election.
