- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to abstinence-based concepts within the school health curriculum.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Abstinence-based concepts Health curriculum.
- Beginning July 1, 2012, each school district shall ensure that its curriculum for health
- 8 includes the exposure of students to abstinence-based concepts, including that:.
 - There are social, psychological, and health gains to be realized by abstaining from sexual activity;
- 11 2. Abstinence is the expected standard for all students;
- 3. Abstinence is the only certain way to avoid out-of-wedlock pregnancy, sexually
 transmitted disease, and other associated health problems;
- 4. A mutually faithful monogamous relationship within the context of marriage is the
 expected standard of human sexual activity;
 - 5. Sexual activity outside the context of marriage is likely to have harmful psychological and physical effects;
- Bearing children out of wedlock is likely to have harmful consequences for the child,
 the child's parents, and society;
- 20 <u>7. There are ways to reject unwanted sexual advances;</u>
- 21 8. Alcohol and drug use increase one's vulnerability to sexual advances; and
- 22 9. It is important to attain economic self-sufficiency before engaging in sexual activity.
