6 **15.1-06-12. Emergency and disaster drills - Implementation.**

- Each <u>public and nonpublic</u> school district superintendent shall <u>implementconduct</u> fire,
 tornado, and other emergency or disaster drills, including lockdown drills.
- 9 2. <u>The lockdown drills required by subsection 1 must:</u>
- 10 <u>a.</u> <u>Be designed by a committee that includes:</u>
- 11(1)The principal of the public school or, in the case of a nonpublic school, the12administrator;
 - (2) <u>A representative of the law enforcement agency that has jurisdiction over</u> the area in which the school is located;
 - (3) A representative of the fire department that has jurisdiction over the area in which the school is located; and
 - (4) A representative of any other emergency response entity recommended by the listed committee members.
- 19b.Be designed to include security measures that are appropriate to situations20involving:
 - (1) The release of a hazardous material; and
 - (2) The presence of an armed individual on or near the school premises.
- 23 <u>c.</u> <u>Occur at least twice during each regular school calendar.</u>
