1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 39-04-18.2 and a new subsection to section

2 57-40.3-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to temporary motor vehicle registration

3 and excise tax; to amend and reenact subdivisions c and e of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18,

4 subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06, and section 39-06.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code,

5 relating to motor vehicle registration; and to declare an emergency.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivisions c and e of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the
8 North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

9 Motor vehicles registered in any other state or territory when coming into this C. 10 state a distance not exceeding twenty miles [32.19 kilometers]; provided. 11 however, that such motor vehicles have displayed thereon the current license 12 plates issued by the state or territory in which they are registered and provided 13 further that the owners or operators thereof are not residents of this state for any 14 purpose and are not gainfully employed or stationed in this state. Nor may such 15 vehicles be required to pay any other tax, and no registration fee or tax may be 16 required when such vehicles do not leave the incorporated limits of any city while 17 in the state of North Dakota within a zone circumscribed by a line running parallel 18 to the corporate limits of any city or contiguous cities and twenty miles [32.19 19 kilometers] distant therefrom. This section does not prevent trucks from coming 20 into the state such distance as shall be necessary to reach the nearest railway 21 shipping station. For purposes of this subdivision, an individual is a resident of 22 this state if the individual is gainfully employed or engages in any trade, 23 profession, or occupation within this state and owns, leases, or rents a place of 24 residence or otherwise lives within this state for the purposes of employment, or

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1		regardless of domicile or any other circumstance, remains in this state for a		
2		period of at least ninety consecutive days. For purposes of this subdivision, a		
3		resident does not include a student at a university, college, or technical school in		
4		this state or a daily commuter from another jurisdiction if that jurisdiction exempts		
5		the vehicle of a daily commuter from this state from registration in that jurisdiction		
6		under a reciprocity agreement.		
7		e. Passenger motor vehicles registered in any other state or territory; provided,		
8		however, that such motor vehicles have displayed thereon the current license		
9		plates issued by the state or territory in which they are registered and provided		
10		further that the owners or operators thereof are not residents of this state for any		
11		purpose and are not gainfully employed or stationed in this state. For purposes of		
12		this subdivision, an individual is a resident of this state if the individual is gainfully		
13		employed or engages in any trade, profession, or occupation within this state and		
14		owns, leases, or rents a place of residence or otherwise lives within this state for		
15		the purposes of employment, or regardless of domicile or any other		
16		circumstance, remains in this state for a period of at least ninety consecutive		
17		days. For purposes of this subdivision, a resident does not include a student at a		
18		university, college, or technical school in this state or a daily commuter from		
19		another jurisdiction if that jurisdiction exempts the vehicle of a daily commuter		
20		from this state from registration in that jurisdiction under a reciprocity agreement.
