- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 54-03-20 and 54-35-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to legislative compensation; to repeal sections 54-03-19.1 and
- 3 54-03-19.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the legislative compensation
- 4 commission; and to provide an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

54-03-20. Compensation and expense reimbursement of members of the legislative assembly.

- Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as compensation for
 services the sum of one hundred forty-eightfifty-two dollars for each calendar day
 during any organizational, special, or regular legislative session and for each day that
 member attends a meeting of a legislative committee between the organizational
 session and the regular session as authorized by legislative rule.
- 15 2. Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive reimbursement for а. 16 lodging, which may not exceed per calendar month the amount established under 17 this subdivision by the director of the office of management and budget for 18 lodging in state and which may not exceed the rate provided in section 44-08-04 19 for each calendar day during the period of any organizational, special, or regular 20 session. On August first of each even-numbered year, the director of the office of 21 management and budget shall set the maximum monthly reimbursement for the 22 subsequent two-year period at an amount equal to thirty times fifty-five percent of 23 the daily lodging reimbursement in effect on that date as provided under 24 subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 44-08-04.

2			(1) A member of the legislative assembly may elect to be reimbursed for less
3			than the amount to which the legislator is entitled under this subsection by
4			claiming the lesser amount on a voucher submitted with the receipt required
5			by section 44-08-04.
6			(2) The legislative management may establish guidelines that may result in a
7			reduced maximum reimbursement for a single dwelling in which two or more
8			legislators share lodging and the total rent for that dwelling exceeds the
9			amount to which a legislator is entitled under subdivision a.
10	3.	a.	Members of the legislative assembly who receive reimbursement for lodging are
11			also entitled to reimbursement for travel for not to exceed one round trip taken
12			during any calendar week, or portion of a week, the legislative assembly is in
13			session, between their residences and the place of meeting of the legislative
14			assembly, at the rate provided for state employees with the additional limitation
15			that reimbursement for travel by common carrier may be only at the cost of coach
16			fare and may not exceed one and one-half times the amount the member would
17			be entitled to receive as mileage reimbursement for travel by motor vehicle.
18		b.	A member of the legislative assembly who does not receive reimbursement for
19			lodging and whose place of residence in the legislative district that the member
20			represents is not within the city of Bismarck is entitled to reimbursement at the
21			rate provided for state employees for necessary travel for not to exceed one
22			round trip taken per day between the residence and the place of meeting of the
23			legislative assembly when it is in session and may receive reimbursement for
24			lodging at the place of meeting of the legislative assembly as provided in section
25			44-08-04 for each calendar day for which round trip travel reimbursement is not
26			claimed, provided that the total reimbursement may not exceed the maximum
27			monthly reimbursement allowed under subdivision a of subsection 2.
28	4.	The	e amount to which each legislator is entitled must be paid following the
29		orga	anizational session in December and following each month during a regular or
30		spe	cial session.

L. 97-34; 28 95 Stat. 202; 26 U.S.C. 162(i)]. 29 Before each regular legislative session, the legislative management shall make 9. 30 recommendations and submit any necessary legislation to adjust legislative 31 compensation amounts.

19	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is				
20	20 amended and reenacted as follows:				
21	21 54-35-10. Compensation of members and leadership.				
22	1.	The members of the legislative management and the members of any committee of			
23		the legislative management are entitled to be compensated for the time spent in			
24		attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees at the rate			
25		of one hundred forty-eightfifty-two dollars per day and must also be paid for expenses			
26		incurred in attending said meetings and in the performance of their official duties in the			
27		amounts provided by law for other state officers.			
28	2.	In addition to the compensation provided in subsection 1, the chairman of the			
29		legislative management is entitled to receive an additional five dollars for each day			
30		spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees,			
31		and the chairman of each of the legislative management's committees is entitled to			

- receive five dollars for each day spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative
 management or of the committee which the person chairs.

- 3 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 4 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 5 54-35-10. Compensation of members and leadership.
- 6 1. The members of the legislative management and the members of any committee of 7 the legislative management are entitled to be compensated for the time spent in 8 attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees at the rate 9 of one hundred fifty-twofifty-seven dollars per day and must also be paid for expenses 10 incurred in attending said meetings and in the performance of their official duties in the 11 amounts provided by law for other state officers. 12 2. In addition to the compensation provided in subsection 1, the chairman of the
- 13 legislative management is entitled to receive an additional five dollars for each day
- 14 spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees,
- 15 and the chairman of each of the legislative management's committees is entitled to
- receive five dollars for each day spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative
 management or of the committee which the person chairs.

18 SECTION 5. REPEAL. Sections 54-03-19.1 and 54-03-19.2 of the North Dakota Century

- 19 Code are repealed.
- 20 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 1, 3, and 5 of this Act become effective on July 1,
- 21 2011, and sections 2 and 4 of this Act become effective on July 1, 2012.
