A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for federally designated head start programs in the
state.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general			
5	fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$6,150,000, or so much of the			
6	sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing			
7	grants to federally designated head start programs in this state, for the biennium beginning			
8	July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.			
9	1.	The	head start state collaboration administrator shall award grants under this section	
10		based on an application and criteria that include:		
11		a.	The number of low-income or at-risk children and families that a program can	
12			serve;	
13		b.	A program's design, service area, and accessibility to eligible children and	
14			families;	
15		C.	A program's coordination and interaction with licensed child care programs and	
16			public and nonpublic schools; and	
17		d.	Proposals for innovative ways of addressing identified needs of eligible children	
18			and families.	
19	2.	In o	rder to be eligible for a grant under this section, a head start unit must be in	
20		com	pliance with all head start performance standards.	
21	3.	The	department shall monitor and provide oversight of grant recipients in conjunction	
22		with	federal head start triennial monitoring.
