- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-29-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to eligibility for the children's health insurance program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-29-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 **50-29-04.** Plan requirements.

- 7 The plan:
- 8 1. Must be provided through private contracts with insurance carriers;
- 9 2. Must allow conversion to another health insurance policy;
- 10 3. Must be based on an actuarial equivalent of a benchmark plan;
- 11 4. Must incorporate every state-required waiver approved by the federal government;
- 12 5. Must include community-based eligibility outreach services; and
- 13 6. Must provide:
- 14 a. A net income eligibility limit of onetwo hundred sixty percent of the poverty line;
- b. A copayment requirement for each pharmaceutical prescription and for each
  emergency room visit;
- 17 c. A deductible for each inpatient hospital visit;
- 18 d. Coverage for:

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- (1) Inpatient hospital, medical, and surgical services;
- (2) Outpatient hospital and medical services;
- (3) Psychiatric and substance abuse services;
- 22 (4) Prescription medications;
  - (5) Preventive screening services;
- 24 (6) Preventive dental and vision services; and

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- 1 (7) Prenatal services; and
- e. A coverage effective date that is the first day of the month, following the date of
  application and determination of eligibility.
