- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 54-21.3-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the state building code.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 54-21.3-03 of the North Dakota

- 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 4. <u>Neither the The</u> state building code <u>noror</u> a building code adopted by a city, township,
- 7 or county may <u>not</u> include a requirement that fire sprinklers be installed in a single
- 8 family dwelling or a residential building that contains no more than two dwelling units.
- 9 The state building code, plumbing code, electrical code, or a building, plumbing, or
- 10 <u>electrical code adopted by a city, township, or county may not include a requirement</u>
- 11 that buildings designed for and used as a school portable classroom have a
- 12 permanent foundation, permanent footings, a permanent bathroom if bathroom
- 13 <u>facilities are located in an adjacent building, permanent plumbing services or fixtures,</u>
- 14 <u>or permanent electrical service. These portable classrooms are exempt from these</u>
- 15 provisions of a building code for ten years after placement. A city, township, or county
- 16 <u>may require that a temporary foundation system be used that provides adequate</u>
- 17 <u>anchoring and structural support. This subsection applies to cities or counties adopting</u>
- 18 <u>a building code under a home rule charter.</u>
