- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 17-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to allocation of wind rights.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 17-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Allocation of wind rights.

- The public service commission shall adopt a unitization formula to proportionately compensate property owners whose wind resources are affected by the siting of a commercial wind energy conversion facility. The formula must provide for a base payment to the owner of the property on which is located a wind turbine. The total amount of compensation under the formula for a wind turbine may only be determined by private negotiations between the owner of the property on which the wind turbine is located and the wind developer or wind turbine owner. Under the formula Of that total amount, the formula must provide for a base payment to the owner of the property on which is located a wind turbine. Of that total amount, any owner of property near the wind turbine whose wind resources are more than minimally impacted by the wind turbine must share in the compensation above the base payment. An owner of property without a wind turbine does not have any rights as to the location of the turbine or the overall compensation for the wind turbine unless otherwise provided by law. An

In addition to compensation under subsection 1, the public service commission shall provide for compensation to an owner of property used as a residence in which the owner does not have a wind turbine that is part of a commercial wind energy conversion facility must receive compensation for each wind turbine that is part of that

- 1 <u>commercial wind energy conversion facility within one-half mile [.80 kilometer] of that</u>
- 2 <u>owner's residence, in addition to any wind resource compensation, for audio, visual,</u>
- 3 <u>and other perceptible impacts.</u>
