- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the use of state dollars to support nonresident students.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Nonresident students - Return of state dollars to general fund.

- 7 <u>1.</u> For each institution under its control, the state board of higher education shall
- 8 determine the amount of state funding per student by dividing the number of full-time
- 9 <u>equivalent students enrolled at the institution into the total amount of state</u>
- 10 <u>appropriations received by the institution.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>The state board of higher education shall multiply the amount of state funding per</u>
- 12 <u>student at each institution, as determined under subsection 1, by the number of</u>
- 13 <u>full-time equivalent nonresident students enrolled at the institution. For purposes of</u>
- 14 this subsection, a nonresident student does not include a student whose residency is
- 15 in a state that has entered a tuition reciprocity agreement with this state, provided the
- student's residence is in a municipality that borders this state, as defined by the state
 board of higher education.
- Each institution shall forward the amount determined under subsection 2 to the state
 treasurer, who shall return the amount to the state general fundEffective with the start
 of the 2011-12 school year, and each school year thereafter, each institution shall pay.
 back fifty percent of the amount determined under subsection 2 to the state general.
 fund for any newly enrolled nonresident students.
