- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 58-02-28 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to disposition of township funds upon dissolution; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 58-02-28 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 58-02-28. When township dissolved Disposition of property and records.
- 7 If a majority of all votes cast at the township meeting are in favor of dissolution, the
- 8 township ceases to be a corporation on the first day of January next succeeding the time of
- 9 holding such meeting January first. The property belonging to the township, after the After
- payment of its the township's debts and liabilities, any funds on hand derived from property
- 11 taxes levied by the township may be allocated among taxpayers of the township in proportion to
- 12 their relative ownership shares of the taxable valuation of property in the township, any funds on
- hand from sources other than property taxes levied by the township must be transferred by the
- 14 township treasurer to the treasurer of the county in which the township is located for deposit in
- 15 the county general fund, and any real or personal property must be disposed of in the manner
- directed by a majority of the voters of the township at any special meeting. All of the records of
- 17 the township records must be turned over for preservation and safekeeping to the county
- auditor of the county within in which the township lies is located.
- 19 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
